1	Skin in bad condition/aged skin	3-4

Mix	(GLOW or REFRESH) Treatment plan	Peeling depth
1	6 treatments (one treatment every 2-4 weeks*), wait 8 weeks. Repeat if necessary	Superficial
2	4-6 treatments (one treatment every 1-3 weeks*), wait 6-8 weeks. Repeat if necessary	Superficial
3	4 treatments (one treatment every 1-2 weeks*), wait 6 weeks. Repeat if necessary	Very superficial

Mix	(PURE) Suitable for	acne
1	Skin in bad condition	acne
2	Skin in medium condition	acne
3	Skin with mild acne problems	acne

Mix	(PURE) Treatment plan	Peeling depth
1	6 treatments (one treatment every 2-4 weeks*), wait 8 weeks. Repeat if necessary	Superficial
2	4-6 treatments (one treatment every 1-3 weeks*), wait 6-8 weeks. Repeat if necessary	Superficial
3	4 treatments (one treatment every 1-2 weeks*), wait 6 weeks. Repeat if necessary	Very superficial

Mix	(GLOW or REFRESH) To maintain results	Glogau*
1	Skin in bad condition/aged skin: One treatment every 6 weeks, or one treatment course with 6 treatments every 4 months.	3-4
2	Skin in medium condition: One treatment every 4-6 weeks, or one treatment course with 4-6 treatments every 4-6 months.	2-3
3	Skin in better condition: One treatment every 6-8 weeks, or one treatment course with 4 treatments every 6 months.	1-2

Glogau classification:		Age:
1	Mild pigmentary changes. No keratoses. Minimal or No wrinkles	20s
2	Early solar lentigines. Rare keratoses. Wrinkles seen only with facial expressions	30s-40s
3	Obvious dyschromia and telangiectasias. Visible keratoses. Wrinkles seen at rest.	50s
4	Sallow (yellow-gray) color. Keratoses and skin malignancies. Wrinkles throughout	60s-70s

**Treatment intervals\***  
 Treatment intervals for peels vary from 1 week to 4 weeks during a series of 4 to 6 treatments, and the interval is determined by the treatment intensity and sensitivity of the patients skin. Very superficial peels are commonly performed at the beginning of a series and treatment intervals are usually every 1-2 weeks, as the skin recovers rapidly from these treatments. More intense superficial peels are associated with a greater degree of exfoliation and require more time for re-epithelization. Superficial peels are typically performed every 3-4 weeks.
